Minutes

President Ty Bland called the meeting of the Historical Society of West Point to order at 3:04 p.m., April 25, 2010. Reverend Bill Palmer gave the opening prayer. Dr. Richard Hosfield gave the Treasurers Report. The current balance is \$11,177.81 with an additional \$10,000 in a certificate of deposit. Dues are being collected for the 2010 year.

The October 18, 2009 meeting minutes were read and accepted as recorded.

Ty reported that the communications tower has generated funds for the Town. Ty reported that he would write a letter to the Town to request half of the funds to go toward a museum for the HSWP.

Gary Smith encouraged members to submit items to him for the website by e-mail or by contacting Ty.

Mark Neale encouraged members to join the planning board to help with serving on committees.

Vice President Cathy Price submitted her resignation for her office. Nomination Chair, John Lee, nominated Jim Dopp for the office. Buddy Evans seconded the nomination and the vote was unanimous in favor of Jim for Vice President.

Jim Dopp reported on his idea of an "M&M Project". The focus would be on the museum and the marina projects. Each project would help the other to improve the economic development of the Town.

The Point of Destiny film was shown to the members. It was raw film of the original shoot at the old ball park at 9:00 PM at night. Marvin Kerby was the narrator.

Following adjournment at 4:15 p.m. refreshments were served. Approximately 68 persons attended the meeting.
